Rain or shine, there is a perfect array of lovely spaces to enjoy at South Farm. Weddings may take place outdoors in the Summerhouse, or indoors, in the Drawing Room within the Farmhouse, the Old Dairy or the splendid Tudor Barn.



The Summerhouse is an exquisite seven-sided oak-framed structure that appears to hover over the lily pond framed by the garden behind. Skilful lighting and stateof-the-art acoustics complete an idyllic open air scene and provide the Bride & Groom with the most romantic of settings, whilst guests look on from across the pond.

The Farmhouse is beautifully furnished in classic country house style with fine old paintings. The Drawing Room is licensed for smaller ceremonies for up to 35 guests. It may also be used for a formal presentation line on arrival, or for drinks for up to 55 guests in conjunction with the Hall.

The Old Dairy seats 100 quests for Wedding Ceremonies and is licensed for 150 party-style. This charming building is ideal as a wet weather alternative to a garden wedding, and for coffee after the Wedding Breakfast.

The Tudor Barn forms the core of South Farm's many and varied entertaining spaces and makes a grand and impressive setting for the Wedding Ceremony. It provides formal seating for 146 for a Wedding Breakfast, and accommodates up to 200 for a party.


